A. Satanic heirarchy opposes God's work

powers, against the rulers of the darkness
of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

A. He would destroy your spiritual life
1. By destroying your confidence in God
2. By diverting attention from Christ

B. Christian has power over Satan

Behold I give you power to tread on
serpents and scorpions, and over all the
power of the enemy: and nothing shall by
any means hurt you.

C. Christian obliged to resist Satan
Resist the devil, and he will flee f
from you.

III. Satan would rob you of your reward

castaway.

A. By satisfaction with the status quo

1. Not being filled with the Spirit

2. Not moving in the Spirit

B. By lethargy

1. Inactivity instead of aggressiveness
