### Introduction

Within every Christian God has placed special treasures designed to show both us and the world the glory and power of our God.

#### I. Our jars of clay

**Romans 9:21 NIV** Does not the potter have the right to make out of the same lump of clay some pottery for noble purposes and some for common use?

- A. The design of the potter
  - 1. Infinite variety -- There are no clones
    - a. Humans come in different shapes and colors
    - b. Each of us has a unique background
    - c. Our families are unique
  - 2. Different purposes -- crankshaft vs. steering wheel
    - a. Not every one can be a Sunday School Teacher, Royal Ranger leader, etc.
      - b. We are of different design for a different purpose
      - Example: "Star" shaped screwdriver for headlights on my Buick
  - 3. Fragile and easily damaged
