- I. What is grace?
 - A. Defined
 - 1. Unmerited or undeserved favor
 - 2. Supernatural ability we receive from God to enable us to live the Christian life in all circumstances
 - B. Grace is an act of God's sovereign will

But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

Genesis 6:8

- II. What grace does
 - A. Grace exposes us to the true nature of God
 - 1. Unconditional love
 - 2. Unconditional grace
 - B. Begins the cycle of knowing God

If I have found favor in your eyes, teach me your ways so I may know you and continue to find favor with you.

Exodus 33:13a NIV

- 1. God gives grace
- 2. We learn God's ways
- 3. He gives more grace
- C. Allows God to walk with us

III. How grace acts

A. It saves

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: [it is] the gift of God:

Ephesians 2:8

B. It justifies

Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

Romans 3:24

C. It changes us

But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which [was bestowed] upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.
