Exodus 8:13-14 (NKJV) So the LORD did according to the word of Moses. And the frogs died out of the houses, out of the courtyards, and out of the fields. 14 They gathered them together in heaps, and the land stank.

A. Death of your precious frogs

Colossians 3:5-6 (NKJV)
Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. 6 Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience,

Romans 6:1-2 (NKJV) What shall we say then? **Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound?** 2 Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?

B. Doing the work of cleansing

Romans 6:12-13 (NKJV) Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. 13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.
