Scripture:

Hebrews 7:25-26 NIV Romans 4:25 NIV

<u>Hebrews 7:25-26 NIV</u> Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through Him because he always lives to intercede for them. {26} Such a high priest meets our need -- one who is holy, blameless, pure, set apart from sinners, exalted above the heavens.

<u>Romans</u> 4:25 **NIV** He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.

Introduction
