

Four Levels of Healing

Scripture: Isaiah 53:5

Isaiah 53:5 KJV But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Introduction

When Jesus went to the cross, He provided complete healing for every portion of our being.

I. Spiritual

Isaiah 53:5a KJV But he was wounded for our transgressions,

Strong's: pasha` peh'-shah from 6586; a revolt (national, moral or religious):--rebellion, sin, transgression, trespass.

- A. Transgression involves rebellion
- B. Taking an action against a known law or precept
- C. Willfully violating a direct command-ment from God

II. Mental

Isaiah 53:5b, 6 KJV ...he was bruised for our iniquities: ...All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Strong's: `avon aw-vone' or oavown (2 Kings 7:9; Psalm 51:5 (7)) (aw-vone') ; from 5753; perversity, i.e. (moral) evil:--fault, iniquity, mischief, punishment (of iniquity), sin.

- A. The battleground of the mind
 - James 1:14 KJV** But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.
 - 1. Sin begins in the mind
 - 2. From concept to rationalization to execution
- B. Torment from past experience
- C. Dealing with fear

III. Emotional

Isaiah 53:5c KJV ...the chastisement of our peace was upon him;

Strong's: shalom shaw-lome' or shalom (shaw-lome') ; from 7999; safe, i.e. (figuratively) well, happy, friendly; also (abstractly) welfare, i.e. health, prosperity, peace:--X do, familiar, X fare, favour, + friend, X great, (good) health, (X perfect,

such as be at) peace(-able, -ably), prosper(-ity, -ous), rest, safe(-ty), salute, welfare, (X all is, be) well, X wholly.

- B. Concerns and doubtings

IV. Physical

Isaiah 53:5d KJV ...and with his stripes we are healed.

Strong's: rapha' raw-faw' or raphah (raw-faw') ; a primitive root; properly, to mend (by stitching), i.e. (figuratively) to cure:--cure, (cause to) heal, physician, repair, X thoroughly, make whole.
