<u>Mark 7:37 NKJV</u> And they were astonished beyond measure, saying, "He has done all things well. He makes both the deaf to hear and the mute to speak."

<u>Mark 7:37 NIV</u> People were overwhelmed with amazement. "He has done everything well," they said. "He even makes the deaf hear and the mute speak."

Introduction

Ours is an era of specialization. Doctors specialize in one small segment of medicine. Attorneys specialize in a specific area of law. On a production line, workers perform a single task repetitively. But whatever Jesus did, he did well.

I. The things he did well

A. He freed the emotionally and spiritually oppressed

<u>Mark 7:30 NKJV</u> And when she had come to her house, she found the demon gone out, and her daughter lying on the bed.

B. He healed the infirm

<u>Mark 7:34-35 NKJV</u> Then, looking up to heaven, He sighed, and said to him, "Ephphatha," that is, "Be opened." {35} Immediately his ears were opened, and the impediment of his tongue was loosed, and he spoke plainly.

C. He befriended the outcast

<u>Matthew 8:2-3 NKJV</u> And behold, a leper came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean." 3 Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

II. What this means to you

<u>Hebrews 7:25 NKJV</u> Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.
