- B. Our secret sins are always exposed in the light of God's presence
  - 1. They are always being revealed in the light
  - 2. They are there because we haven't repented
- C. Our secret sins cause us to lose control of our lives

### III. How to be free from secret sin

**Proverbs 28:13 NIV** He who conceals his sins does not prosper, but whoever <u>confesses and renounces</u> them finds mercy.

<u>Matthew 22:29 N/V</u> Jesus replied, "You are in error because you do not know the Scriptures or the power of God."

- A. Confess to God
- B. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you the ability to overcome your secret sin
- C. Appropriate your inheritance, the power of God

Luke 9:1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over

all devils, and to cure diseases.

<u>Luke 10:19</u> {Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.}
