Romans 8:29 (NKJV) For whom He foreknew, He also **predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son**, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

<u>1 John 3:2 (NKJV)</u> Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like **Him**, for we shall see Him as He is.

- I. What Jesus demonstrated himself to be
 - **2** Corinthians 8:9 (NKJV) For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.
 - A. He made himself nothing

<u>Philippians 2:7a (NKJV)</u> but made <u>Himself of no reputation</u>

B. He became a servant

<u>Philippians 2:7b (NKJV)</u> taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.

C. He humbled himself

Philippians 2:8a (NKJV) And being found in appearance as a man, **He humbled Himself**

D. He became obedient

<u>Philippians 2:8b (NKJV)</u> and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

- II. What he expects us to become
 - <u>1 Peter 2:21 (NKJV)</u> For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, *that you should follow His steps*:
 - A. Trust Him as our only resource
 - **2** Corinthians 3:5 (NKJV) Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God,
 - B. Develop the heart of a servant
 - <u>Matthew 20:26 (NKJV)</u> "Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant.
 - C. Realize He alone gets the credit for what we

achieve

Isaiah 42:8 (NKJV) I am the LORD, that is My name; And My glory I will not give to another, Nor My praise to carved images.

Revelation 22:16 (NKJV) "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. **I am** the Root and the Offspring of David, **the Bright and Morning Star**."

- D. Live a life of obedience to His will
 - <u>1 John 2:17 (NKJV)</u> And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.

III. How to become like him

- <u>1 Peter 5:6 (NKJV)</u> Therefore *humble* yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,
- A. Be willing to be nothing that He can be everything

Philippians 3:7 (NKJV) But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ.

B. Be willing to serve

Matthew 25:21 (NKJV) "His lord said to him, 'Well done, **good and faithful servant**; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.'

- C. Be willing to place the credit where it belongs
 - <u>1 Corinthians 15:28 (NKJV)</u> Now when all things are made subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, *that God may be all in all*.
- D. Learn to say "Yes" to His will

<u>Acts 21:14 (NKJV)</u> So when he would not be persuaded, we ceased, saying, "The will of the Lord be done."
