Introduction

What a tremendous statement of the compassion and concern of the Holy Spirit -- from falling on his face to being lifted up by the Holy Spirit!

- B. Sin causes the heavens to be closed to us

  When the heavens are shut up and there is no rain
  because your people have sinned against you....

- C. The prayer of repentence will cause His Spirit to lift you up
