Genesis 5:21-24 KJV And Enoch lived sixty and five years, and begat Methuselah: And Enoch walked with God after he begat Methuselah three hundred years, and begat sons and daughters: And all the days of Enoch were three hundred sixty and five years: And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.

<u>Hebrews 11:5 KJV</u> By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

- C. Was motivated to please God

II. The translation of Elijah

<u>2 Kings 2:11 NIV</u> As they were walking along and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire and horses of fire appeared and separated the two of them, and Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind.

- A. Characterized by his power with God
 - 1. A drought came at his word
 - 2. Fire from heaven at his word
 - 3. Rain at his word
- B. His spiritual "roller coaster"
- C. His victorious exit from this world

III. The translation of the church

Luke 21 :36 KJV Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape al I these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

<u>Matthew 7:21 NIV</u> Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord," will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.
