## The Final Destination

Scripture: Jude 1:24-25

Jude 1:24-25 KJV Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, 25 To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

#### Introduction

These verses are the doxology of the book of Jude. They express the will of the Father and the Son for every believer.

### I. Now unto Him who is able

Acts 20:32 KIV And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

- A. To speak the universe into existence
- B. To deliver Israel from Egypt
- C. To provide a path through the Red Sea
- D. To provide water in the desert
- E. To save the three Hebrews from the fire
- F. To save Daniel from the lions
- G. To calm the raging sea
- H. To raise Lazarus from the dead
- I. To preserve Paul after his shipwreck

### II. To keep you from falling

**Romans 8:35, 37-39 KJV** Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? **37** Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. **38** For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, **39** Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- A. In time of temptation
  - <u>1 Corinthians</u> 10:13 KJV There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.
- B. When grace to live is needed

<u>Hebrews 4:16 KJV</u> Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

C. To triumph over the accuser of the brethren

**Revelation 12:10 KJV** And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

#### III. And present you faultless

**2** Corinthians 1:11 KJV For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

- A. The Lord constantly intercedes on our behalf <u>Hebrews 7:25 KJV</u> Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- B. He will present a glorious church

Ephesians 5:27 KJV That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

C. We will be like him

1 John 3:2 KJV Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

# IV. Before the Presence of His glory with exceeding joy

*I Corinthians 2:9 KJV* But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

**Revelation 7:9 KJV** After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

John 17:22-24 KJV And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: 23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me. 24 Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given

me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.

Revelation 21:2-4 KJV And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. 3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. 4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.
