Even Now

Scriptuure: John 11:22

John 11:22 KJV But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee.

Introduction

It was a devastating time for Mary and Martha. Their brother had become critically ill. They had sent for their friend, Jesus, and he did not come. Their brother had died and had been in the grave for three days when Jesus arrived. Many questions filled their minds. Why had Jesus delayed his coming? Did he not even care?

But when Jesus finally arrived, Martha made one of the most profound declarations of faith recorded in the scripture.

I. Disqualifying moments

John 11:21 KJV Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.

- A. Poor decisions
 - 1. Jonah

Jonah 1:3 KJV But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to Tarshish: **so he paid the fare thereof**, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord.

2. John Mark

Acts 13:13 KJV Now when Paul and his company loosed from Paphos, they came to Perga in Pamphylia: and John departing from them returned to Jerusalem.

- B. Missed opportunities
 - 1. The ten virgins

Matthew 25:10 KJV And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut.

2. Joash, King of Israel

2 Kings 13:18-19 KJV And he said, Take the arrows. And he took them. And he said unto the king of Israel, Smite upon the ground. And he smote thrice, and stayed. ¹⁹ And the man of God was wroth with him, and said, Thou shouldest have smitten five or six times; then hadst thou smitten Syria till thou hadst consumed it: whereas now thou shalt smite Syria but thrice.

 - 1. Samson

Judges 16:20 KJV And she said, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And he awoke out of his sleep, and said, I will go out as at other times before, and shake myself. And he wist not that the Lord was departed from him.

Hebrews 11:32 KJV And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of **Samson**, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets:

2. Peter

Mark 16:7 KJV But go your way, tell his disciples and Peter that he goeth before you into Galilee: there shall ye see him, as he said unto you.
