Introduction

I. The Christian must have a strong devotional life

Jude 1:20-21 KJV But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

- A. Build yourselves on your most holy faith
- B. Praying in the Holy Ghost

Romans 8:26, 27b KJV Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. ... because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

- C. Keep yourselves in the love of God
- D. Looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life

II. The Christian must seek for mastery

<u>1 Corinthians 9:25a KJV</u> And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things

2 Timothy 2:5 KJV And if a man also strive for masteries, yet he is not crowned, except he strive lawfully.

 - <u>2 Timothy 4:7</u> I have fought a good fight, have finished my course, I have kept the faith
- 6. The prize won

2 Timothy 4:8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day; and not to me only, but to all them also that love his appearing.

III. The price of mastery of God's Word

<u>Colossians 3:16</u> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

Introduction

"So then, faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." (Romans 10:17)

I. Use the Word

Joshua 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do all according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

<u>John 14:21a</u> He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me:

Matthew 7:21 Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

- A. In conversation
- B. In meditation
- C. In practice through obedience
 - 1. Obedience is not convenience
 - 2. <u>Matthew</u> 7:24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him to a wise man, which built his house upon a rock.

II. Respect its authority

John 17:17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

- A. Authority -- legal or rightful power; a right to command or to act
- B. Use its authority

<u>Luke 10:19</u> Behold I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the

enemy and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

III. Value the word

<u>2 Timothy 3:16-17</u> All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.
