#### A. Daniel

- 1. Served under three kings
- 2. Did not seek to be popular
- Delivered unpopular messages from God

#### B. Joseph

- Refused the alluring charms of Potifar's wife
- 2. Was faithful as a jailer's trustee
- 3. Was faithful in Pharoah's service
