I. The goal

1 Corinthians 9:25b, 24b NIV They do it to get a crown that will not last; but we do it to get a crown that will last forever. Run in such a way as to get the prize.

- A. To successfully complete our Christian life
- B. To stand before God uncondemned
- C. To receive the victor's commendation

<u>Matthew 25:2la NIV</u> His master replied, "Well done, good and faithful servant.

II. The discipline

- <u>1 Corinthians 9:25a NIV</u> Everyone who competes in the games goes into strict training.
- A. Involves conditioning

Hebrews 12:1b NIV ...let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perserverance the race marked out for us.

- B. Involves commitment
 - <u>1 Corinthians 9:26 NIV</u> Therefore I do not run like a man running aimlessly; I do not fight like one beating the air.
- C. Involves coordination
 - <u>1 Corinthians 12:18 NIV</u> But in fact God has arranged the parts in the body, just as he wanted them to be.

III. The danger

- **1** Corinthians 9:27 NIV No, I beat my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize.
