## Introduction

In recent years, a philosophy has entered the church in western nations that Christians will never suffer, and that it is never God's will for a Christian to suffer. Nothing could be farther from the truth.

I. Let them that suffer according to the will of God

<u>**1** Peter 4:12 NIV</u> Dear friends, do not be surprised at the painful trial you are suffering, as though something strange were happening to you.

A. Suffering because of the actions of the flesh

<u>Galatians 6:7-8 NIV</u> Do not be deceived. God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.

**Example:** David after his sin with Bathsheba

- B. Suffering because of satanic oppression
  <u>Job 2:6 NIV</u> The Lord said to Satan,
  "Very well, then, he is in your hands; but you must spare his life.
  Example: Job's testing
- C. Suffering because of God's discipline process

<u>2</u> Corinthians 12:8-9 NIV Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Example: Paul's "thorn in the flesh"

## II. Commit the keeping of their souls unto Him <u>2 Timothy 1:12 NIV</u> ...Yet I am not ashamed, because I know whom I have

believed, and am convinced that He is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day.

A. The body is not redeemed

- 1. Romans 8:22-23 cf. 1 Corinthians 5:1-5
- 2. All men have an appointment with death

Hebrews 9:27a NIV Just as man is destined to die once ....

- B. Death, sins first penalty, has not been removed
- 1 Corinthians 15:26 NIV The last enemy to be destroyed is death.
- C. God is the keeper of the soul
- D. God's emphasis is on the spiritual

## III. As unto a faithful Creator

<u>**1** Thessalonians 5:24 NIV</u> The one who calls you is faithful and he will do it.

<u>2 Thessalonians 3:3 NIV</u> But the, Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.

- A. Faithful to you in your temptation
  - <u>1 Corinthians 10:13 NIV</u> No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you are able to bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.
- B. Faithful to you in your suffering
- C. Faithful to you in every situation
