Introduction

I. He is the God who created all things

John 1:3 NIV Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that was made.

Colossians 1:16-17 NIV For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

- A. He set the universe precisely into place

II. He is the God who guides all affairs of men

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Isaiah 30:21 NIV Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you saying, "This is the way; walk in it."

John 16:13 NIV But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

- B. He reveals His will daily

- C. He gave his Spirit to be our constant guide

III. He is the God who gives salvation

Matthew 14:29b-30 NIV Then Peter got down out of the boat and walked on the water to Jesus. But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!"
