I. He is able to save completely

Romans 8:35, 37-39 NIV Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

II. Those who come to God through Him

Acts 4:12 NIV Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.

Hebrews 4:15-16 NIV For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are -- yet was without sin. Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in our time of need.

A. We can only come to God through Jesus Christ

John 15:16b NIV Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name.
