John 7:37-39

### Introduction

#### I. The well of salvation

**Isaiah 12:3 NIV** With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

#### II. The wellspring which provides salvation, Jesus Christ

**John 4:13-14 NIV** Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

- B. Jesus Christ is the means of fellowship with God
- C. Jesus Christ is the source of spiritual life

#### III. The river of life in the Spirit

**John 7:37-39a NIV** On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "If a man is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him." "By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive.... "
