Introduction

- B. He knows personal weaknesses
- C. He knows your greatest areas of temptation

II. He has given direction in His word to show you the proper way to successfully live

2 Peter 1:3 NIV His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his glory and goodness.

- A. The scripture is filled with both positive and negative instructions
- B. There are things to do; there are things to avoid

III. He has given you the ability to turn your failures into successes

Philippians 4:13 NIV I can do everything through him who gives me strength.

- A. For some, failure is a disincentive to try again
- B. For others, failure simply shows another way that success cannot be achieved
