Introduction

I. Know your enemy

1 Peter 5:8Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

 - 1. To deceive
 - 2. To masquerade

II. Know your ally

<u>Psalm 118:6</u> The Lord is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?

<u>Psalm 56:9</u> When I cry unto thee, then my enemies turn back: this I know; FOR GOD IS FOR ME.

Romans 8:31 What shall we say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

A. He is Jehovah-nissi

Isaiah 59:19 When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.

B. He is Jehovah-shammah

<u>Ezekiel 48:19</u> ...and the name of that city from that day shall be, The Lord is there

C. Your battle is His battle

<u>1 Peter 5:7</u> Casting all your cares upon him, for he careth for you.

III. Know that God gives you victory

<u>Psalm 91:14-16</u> Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honor him. With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.

<u>1 Corinthians 4:8-9</u> We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair. Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed;

- B. When the enemy is the wicked
 - 1. Sennacharib 2 Kings 19
 - 2. Jehoshaphat 2 Chronicles 20
- C. When the enemy is a brother in the church

Psalm 55:12-14 It was not an enemy that reproached me; then I could have borne it: neither was it he that hated me that did magnify himself against me; then I would have hid myself from him.
