 - a. Does a deer expose the fawn to the wolf?
 - b. Does the rabbit expose its young to the fox?
 - 2. How will our children be able to make a choice if they don't know evil?
 - a. Their knowledge of evil must be from a scriptural vantage point
 - They must know scriptural precepts and be mature before they are exposed to evil
- B. Do not possess experiential knowledge of the works of the flesh

Galatians 6:19-21 Now the works of the flesh are manifest which are these; adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murder, drunkenness, revelings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.
