II. It is a list of those delivered from Satan's captivity to become conquering heroes

<u>Colossians 1:13</u> Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son.

A. Delivered from the jaws of defeat

<u>2 Timothy 4:18</u> And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen
