I. The implications for man's spiritual nature

Psalm 103:3a, 4a He forgives all my sins

- A. Forgiveness

II. The implications for man's physical nature

<u>Psalm 103:3b, 5a</u> ...and heals all my diseases ... He satisfies my desires with good things....

<u>James 5:15</u> And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up.

<u>Philippians 4:19</u> And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

- A. He will heal our bodies
- B. He will provide for us

III. The implications for man's emotional nature

<u>**Psalm 103:4b</u>** ...and crowns me with love and compassion.</u>

- A. Our emotions will be brought under control
- B. Our emotional makeup will be changed
- C. Negative emotions replaced by positive emotions

IV. The implications for man's mental nature

<u>Psalm 103:5b</u> ...so that my youth is renewed like an eagle.

<u>Philippians 4:7</u> And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will keep your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

- A. Right relationship with God gives peace
- B. God will garrison and mount guard over you heart and mind
